NOTICE OF INVESTIGATION

THIS IS AN INVESTIGATION to consider the condition of the grade crossing of the Wisconsin Central Ltd. tracks with Good Hope Road in the Village of Sussex, Waukesha County (Crossing No. 692 253 S / MP 107.79). The Office of the Commissioner of Railroads (OCR) opens this docket by its authority under Wis. Stat. ch. 195.

DOCUMENTS. The OCR publishes all notices, orders, proposed decisions and final decisions on the Internet. INTERVENTION. Interested persons may participate in this investigation without becoming a party. However, any person desiring to become a party shall file a request for party status, known as a request to intervene, under Wis. Stat. § 227.44(2m) and Wis. Admin. Code § RR 1.02(1)(c) no later than 14 days from the date of service of this notice using the ERF system.

To file such a request, go to the Commission's web site at <http://psc.wi.gov>, click on the "ERF - Electronic Regulatory Filing" graphic on the side menu bar. On the next page, click on "Need Help?" for instructions on how to upload a document.

A person desiring to become a party who lacks access to the Internet shall make a request to intervene by U.S. mail addressed to:

At the time of filing, the person making the request to intervene shall serve a copy of the request on existing parties. At this time, the Wisconsin Central Ltd. and the Village of Sussex are parties. An existing party may respond to the request within 5 days of service.

WISCONSIN ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY ACT. Under Wis. Admin. Code § RR 1.13(2), this investigation does not require the preparation of an environmental impact statement.

ASSESSMENT. The OCR finds that the expenses that are reasonably attributable to this investigation will be assessed against the Wisconsin Central Ltd. in accordance with Wis. Stat. § 195.60 and Wis. Admin. Code § RR 2.04.

AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT. The OCR does not discriminate on the basis of disability in the provision of programs, services, or employment. The OCR is located in Room 110 of the Commission's Building at 610 N. Whitney Way, Madison, Wisconsin 53707. The Commission Building is accessible to people in wheelchairs through the Whitney Way first floor (lobby) entrance.
