NOTICE IS GIVEN that the Office of the Commissioner of Railroads (OCR) has rescheduled¹ the public hearing in this proceeding for **Tuesday, August 30, 2016, at 1:00 p.m.**, in the Amnicon Falls Hearing Room at the Public Service Commission Building, 610 North Whitney Way, Madison, Wisconsin; and, **by phone** from the Cross Plains Village Hall, 2417 Brewery Road, Cross Plains, WI 53528. The hearing will commence with a public session where the OCR shall receive comments from the available public. Directly after the public session, the OCR shall receive comments from the parties. The presiding Administrative Law Judge may allot additional time to receive evidence and comments, if necessary.

This is a Class 1 proceeding as defined in Wis. Stat. § 227.01(3)(a).

The OCR will not accept comments submitted via e-mail or facsimile (fax).

A person shall limit a public comment to non-technical personal knowledge or personal opinion. A person may include references to other materials in a comment, but may not include as part of a comment, any document not written or substantially modified by that person. The OCR shall only accept documents that a person offers to supplement a comment for the purpose of showing the basis of an opinion, not for proof of the matter asserted. Parties may object to the receipt of a public comment.

Any material submitted to the OCR is a public record and may appear on the OCR web site. Only one comment may be submitted per person during a comment period. The OCR may reject a comment that does not comply with the requirements described in this notice.
