**PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN**

Application of Global Connection, Inc., of America for Designation as  
an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier

2282-TI-100

**FINAL DECISION**

This is the Order in the investigation to determine whether to designate Global Connection, Inc., d/b/a STANDUP WIRELESS (Global), as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (ETC), pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 214(e)(2) and Wis. Admin. Code § PSC 160.13. Designation as an ETC makes a provider eligible to receive State and Federal Universal Service Fund (USF) monies. Global sought designation to receive USF only for the low-income Lifeline program. This Final Decision addresses Global's request for designation as a Lifeline-only ETC.

**Introduction**

Global filed a petition for designation as an ETC on April 12, 2012. Global requested ETC designation in the wire centers identified in its application, which are set forth in Appendix A and Appendix B to this Final Decision. Global sought ETC designation for the purpose of receiving low-income support through the Lifeline program. Since the company is operating as a reseller of wireless services, it relies on forbearance of the "own facilities" requirement of 47 U.S.C. § 214(e)(1)(A). The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) grants such forbearance contingent on approval of a compliance plan identifying a company's plan to

comply with requirements established in the FCC's recent Order to reform the Lifeline program.<sup>1</sup> Global's compliance plan was approved by the FCC on May 25, 2012.<sup>2</sup>

The Commission issued a Notice of Investigation and Request for Comments in this docket on June 15, 2012, with comments due on or before June 29, 2011. No comments were received.

### **Findings of Fact**

1. Global is a prepaid wireless provider serving in the wire centers listed in Appendices A and B of this Final Decision.
2. Global will not seek high cost support from the state or federal USF.
3. Global has committed to providing service to all requesting customers, and to advertising the availability of its service, throughout the exchanges in which it provides service, as required under 47 U.S.C. § 214(e) and Wis. Admin. Code § PSC 160.13.
4. Global has committed to providing service which meets the requirements set forth in Wis. Admin. Code § PSC 160.13, but sought waivers of some of the requirements.
5. The PSCW finds no evidence of cream-skimming in Global's application.
6. Global's status as a prepaid wireless provider and the administrative difficulty of applying some requirements of Wis. Admin. Code ch. PSC 160 creates an unusual circumstance that justifies adopting different requirements concerning the pay phone requirement, the minimum monthly charge, and the minimum monthly discount.

7. It is reasonable to adopt a requirement concerning pay phones other than the one set forth in Wis. Admin. Code § PSC 160.13(1)(d). It is reasonable to require Global to work with other providers to ensure that there is at least one pay phone in each municipality.

8. It is reasonable to require Global to provide a monthly credit in the form of minutes, in lieu of the dollar discounts set forth in Wis. Admin. Code § PSC 160.062(2)(b).

9. It is reasonable to *not* require Global to charge a minimum monthly fee, as set forth in Wis. Admin. Code § PSC 160.062(2)(c).

10. It is reasonable to require that Global discontinue service to, and collection of Lifeline support related to, any Lifeline phone with no usage in a 60-day period.

11. It is reasonable to require that Global file periodic reports, as described below, on the numbers of phones disconnected due to no usage in a 60-day period.

12. It is reasonable and in the public interest to designate Global as an ETC for the purpose of receiving Lifeline support in the areas indicated in its application and consistent with this Final Decision.

### **Conclusions of Law**

1. The Commission has jurisdiction and authority under Wis. Stat. §§ 196.02, 196.016 and 196.218; Wis. Admin. Code ch. PSC 160; 47 U.S.C. §§ 214 and 254; and other pertinent provisions of Wis. Stat. ch. 196 and the Telecommunications Act of 1996 to make the above Findings of Fact and to issue this Final Decision.

2. The Commission has the authority to adopt different ETC requirements under Wis. Admin. Code § PSC 160.01(2)(b).

### Opinion

ETC status was created by the 1996 Telecommunications Act and codified in 47 U.S.C. § 214(e)(2). Under FCC rules, 47 U.S.C. § 214(e)(2) and 47 C.F.R. § 54.201(b), state commissions designate providers as ETCs. Designation as an ETC is required if a provider is to receive federal universal service funding. ETC designation is also required to receive funding from the state universal service High Rate Assistance Credit program.

The FCC has established a set of minimum criteria that all ETCs must meet, which is codified at 47 U.S.C. § 214(e)(1) and 47 C.F.R. § 54.101(a), *et seq.* States have the authority to adopt additional requirements, provided that the additional requirements are “not inconsistent with the Commission’s rules to preserve and advance universal service.” 47 U.S.C. § 254(f). The United States Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit upheld the states’ right to impose additional conditions on ETCs in *Texas Office of Public Utility Counsel v. FCC*, 183 F.3d 393, 418 (5<sup>th</sup> Cir. 1999).

The Commission promulgated Wis. Admin. Code § PSC 160.13 to govern ETC designations and requirements in Wisconsin. Those rules established the process for ETC designation and set forth a minimum set of requirements for providers seeking ETC designation from the Commission.

Global plans to offer prepaid wireless Lifeline service without a monthly fee, in much the same manner as other providers previously designated as ETCs by the Commission.<sup>3</sup> Under its proposal, Global would supply the Lifeline customer with a cell phone at no monthly charge. In place of the traditional Lifeline service discount to the monthly rate, Global would provide a set

amount of minutes, without charge, each month. Doing so would normally be at odds with Wis. Admin. Code § PSC 160.062(2)(c), which requires a minimum monthly charge for service.<sup>4</sup> Global seeks the same treatment as other prepaid wireless providers, namely that no minimum charge apply. The Commission has the authority to do so under Wis. Admin. Code § PSC 160.01(2)(b).<sup>5</sup>

In the TracFone docket, the Commission was concerned that the lack of a minimum charge would eliminate automatic notification that a customer had lost, abandoned or otherwise ceased using the service. With traditional service, this becomes apparent when the customer stops paying his or her bills. In the earlier dockets, the Commission required the companies to develop a plan to monitor usage, to cease receiving subsidies for inactive phones, and to report certain information to the Commission on a quarterly basis. Global has requested that the Commission apply the same conditions to it.

Global has requested that the monthly discount set forth in Wis. Admin. Code § PSC 160.062(2)(b) not be applied to Global. Instead, Global will provide a monthly discount in the form of a set number of minutes of use to such customers. Initially, Global would provide customers with a pool of at least 100 free minutes, which can be used for calls or text messages, in lieu of the monthly credit. In the future, this equivalency may change. As it did in the TracFone docket, the Commission delegates to the Administrator of the Telecommunications Division authority to approve or deny changes to the monthly minute allocation.

Providing free monthly minutes of service in lieu of a monthly discount is an alternative approach to Lifeline service. Global's business plan and status as a prepaid wireless provider creates an unusual circumstance that justifies adopting different requirements concerning these items. The Commission adopted a different method of applying discounts and a different minimum charge in earlier dockets. It is reasonable to modify the monthly discount requirement and adopt a similar approach to Global as has been adopted in past dockets.

Also, in the earlier prepaid wireless ETC dockets, the Commission required the companies to make quarterly filings of the number of customers who were deactivated after 60 days of non-usage and the number of days between the 60<sup>th</sup> day and deactivation (reported as a range and an average). It is reasonable to apply the same reporting requirements to Global.

Global has also requested a waiver from the requirement that an ETC provide a pay phone in each municipality, as set forth in Wis. Admin. Code § PSC 160.13(1)(d). In earlier dockets, the Commission determined that it would be burdensome and redundant for a prepaid wireless provider to provide a pay phone. Given this, it is reasonable to apply waiver of this requirement as has been done in the past. Global is required to work with the other providers in their service areas to jointly ensure that pay phones are available.

The FCC has determined that an applicant should be designated as an ETC only where such designation serves the public interest, regardless of whether the area where designation is sought is served by a rural or non-rural provider.<sup>6</sup> The Commission finds that it is in the public interest to designate Global as an ETC in the areas for which Global requests such designation. The Commission is guided by the factors set forth in Wis. Stat. § 196.03(6) when making a public interest determination. The Commission finds that although there are other ETCs in the

areas at issue, designating Global as an ETC will nonetheless increase competition in those areas and, consequently, will increase consumer choice. The Commission also notes that the prepaid wireless offering, especially Global's Lifeline offering, will likely make service available to customers that would not otherwise be served.

The Commission finds that Global meets the requirements for ETC designation.<sup>7</sup>

Finally, while it may not be necessary to do so in the Lifeline-only ETC context, in earlier ETC dockets, the Commission has considered whether there is a concern that an ETC will "cream skim" the most profitable customers.<sup>8</sup> Since Global has requested ETC status for the entirety of its service territory, the Commission finds no evidence of cream-skimming in this docket.

Finally, an issue remains with respect to the wire centers covered by this ETC designation. Global has requested ETC designation in all or portions of a number of wire centers in Wisconsin. These wire centers are identified in Appendices A and B. Since Global serves the entirety of wire centers identified in Appendix A, the ETC designation for these areas will be effective as of the effective date of this Final Decision.

However, Global currently serves, and requests ETC designation in, only a portion of the wire centers identified in Appendix B. As a general policy, the FCC requires the boundaries of areas in which a provider is designated as an ETC to match the boundaries of ILEC study areas. The FCC has, in certain circumstances, granted Lifeline-only providers forbearance from this requirement. The Commission has previously designated providers as ETC's in partial wire

centers contingent on FCC approval, and does so here as well. Therefore, Global's ETC designation in the partial wire centers identified in Appendix B is conditioned upon receipt of a forbearance Order from the FCC. If it receives a forbearance Order from the FCC, Global will not have to seek additional approvals from this Commission to obtain ETC designation in these areas.

### **Order**

1. Global is designated as an ETC, for the purpose of receiving Lifeline support, throughout the wire centers identified in Attachment A.

2. Global is conditionally designated as an ETC, for the purpose of receiving Lifeline support, in the wire centers (or parts thereof) identified in Attachment B. Such designation is conditioned on the FCC granting the requested forbearance.

3. Global is an ETC within the meaning of 47 U.S.C. § 214(c), and is eligible to receive federal USF funding, for Lifeline service, pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 254(2). This Final Decision constitutes the Commission's certification to that effect, subject to order point 2.

4. Global does not have to meet the requirement under Wis. Admin. Code § PSC 165.088 that it provide a pay phone in each incorporated municipality, but Global is instead required to work with other providers in its service territory to jointly ensure that pay phones are available.

5. Global does not have to meet the monetary discount or minimum charge requirements under Wis. Admin. Code § PSC 160.062(2), but Global is instead required to provide at least 100 minutes of free service per month to Lifeline customers. The Commission delegates to the Administrator of the Telecommunications Division authority to approve changes

to that number of minutes. Changes to the number of minutes may be approved without reopening the docket, issuing a notice or providing opportunity for comment.

6. Global must deactivate any Lifeline phone that has had no usage in a 60-day period. Global shall not collect Lifeline support for phones deactivated in this manner.


7. Global must report, on a quarterly basis, the number of customers who were deactivated after 60 days of non-usage and the number of days between the 60<sup>th</sup> day and deactivation (reported as a range and an average).

8. Jurisdiction is maintained.

9. This Final Decision is effective the day after mailing.

**NOTICE OF RIGHTS FOR REHEARING OR JUDICIAL REVIEW, THE  
TIMES ALLOWED FOR EACH, AND THE IDENTIFICATION OF THE  
PARTY TO BE NAMED AS RESPONDENT**

The following notice is served on you as part of the Commission's written decision. This general notice is for the purpose of ensuring compliance with Wis. Stat. § 227.48(2), and does not constitute a conclusion or admission that any particular party or person is necessarily aggrieved or that any particular decision or order is final or judicially reviewable.

*PETITION FOR REHEARING*

If this decision is an order following a contested case proceeding as defined in Wis. Stat. § 227.01(3), a person aggrieved by the decision has a right to petition the Commission for rehearing within 20 days of mailing of this decision, as provided in Wis. Stat. § 227.49. The mailing date is shown on the first page. If there is no date on the first page, the date of mailing is shown immediately above the signature line. The petition for rehearing must be filed with the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin and served on the parties. An appeal of this decision may also be taken directly to circuit court through the filing of a petition for judicial review. It is not necessary to first petition for rehearing.

*PETITION FOR JUDICIAL REVIEW*

A person aggrieved by this decision has a right to petition for judicial review as provided in Wis. Stat. § 227.53. In a contested case, the petition must be filed in circuit court and served upon the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin within 30 days of mailing of this decision if there has been no petition for rehearing. If a timely petition for rehearing has been filed, the petition for judicial review must be filed within 30 days of mailing of the order finally disposing of the petition for rehearing, or within 30 days after the final disposition of the petition for rehearing by operation of law pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.49(5), whichever is sooner. If an *untimely* petition for rehearing is filed, the 30-day period to petition for judicial review commences the date the Commission mailed its original decision.<sup>9</sup> The Public Service Commission of Wisconsin must be named as respondent in the petition for judicial review.

If this decision is an order denying rehearing, a person aggrieved who wishes to appeal must seek judicial review rather than rehearing. A second petition for rehearing is not permitted.
