Re: Rescission of Interconnection Agreement Adoption in Wisconsin

Dear Mr. Iannuzzi:

This letter confirms the agreement by Verizon North Inc. ("Verizon") with respect to the rescission by TelNet Worldwide, Inc. ("TWI") of its adoption of the interconnection agreement between AT&T Communications of Wisconsin, Inc. ("AT&T") and Verizon in Wisconsin.

As you know, on December 10, 2004, Verizon and AT&T filed with the Wisconsin Public Service Commission an amendment, effective as of November 1, 2004 (the "Amendment"), to their Interconnection Agreement, dealing with matters such as intercarrier compensation and interconnection architecture. By its terms, the Amendment "amends each of the Interconnection Agreements by and between each of the Verizon incumbent local exchange carrier affiliates and each of the AT&T wireline competitive local exchange carrier affiliates." The Amendment was approved by the Wisconsin Public Service Commission (the "Commission") on February 18, 2005.

On June 17, 2005, Verizon and TWI filed a letter with the Commission (dated May 25, 2005) that provided for the adoption by TWI of the foregoing AT&T/Verizon interconnection agreement, as amended, including the Amendment discussed above (the "Adoption"). Subsequent to such Adoption, TWI informed Verizon that TWI had not understood that, by virtue of the Adoption, the Amendment would apply to all of TWI's (and its CLEC affiliates') interconnection agreements with Verizon (and Verizon's ILEC affiliates) not only in Wisconsin but, also, outside of Wisconsin. Given the foregoing,

TWI stated that it wished to rescind the Adoption. Given the particular facts and circumstances in this instance, Verizon does not object to such rescission, effective as of May 25, 2005.

As TWI does not currently operate in Wisconsin (nor has it operated in Wisconsin since May 25, 2005), the rescission of the Adoption does not raise any operational or other issues that the parties need to address.

Please execute this letter in the space provided below to reflect your concurrence with the terms hereof. Once executed, please return an original to me, a copy of which Verizon will file with the Commission.


