**AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN  
TDS METROCOM, LLC  
AND  
Wisconsin Bell, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Wisconsin**

This Amendment (the "Amendment") amends the Interconnection Agreement under Sections 251 and 252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 by and between Wisconsin Bell, Inc. d/b/a **AT&T WISCONSIN** ("**AT&T WISCONSIN**") and TDS Metrocom, LLC ("CLEC"). **AT&T WISCONSIN** and CLEC are hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Parties" and individually as a "Party".

**WHEREAS**, **AT&T WISCONSIN** and CLEC are parties to an Interconnection Agreement under Sections 251 and 252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1934, as amended (the "Act"), approved June 7, 2002 and as subsequently amended (the "Agreement"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties desire to modify certain rates and terms related to Emergency Number Service Access; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the promises and mutual agreements set forth herein, the Parties agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. In Appendix 911, Parties agree to delete Section 1.4 and to replace Section 8.1 with the following:

8.1 Rates for Emergency Number Service Access are set forth in the Appendix Pricing in Exhibit A attached.
2. **AT&T WISCONSIN** shall no longer provide ANI/ALI/SR and Database Management Access Routing Files, also known as the Master Street Address Guide (MSAG), via CD-ROM, and the CD-ROM rate.
3. Conflict between this Amendment and the Agreement. This Amendment shall be deemed to revise the terms and provisions of the Agreement only to the extent necessary to give effect to the terms and provisions of this Amendment. In the event of a conflict between the terms and provisions of this Amendment and the terms and provisions of the Agreement this Amendment shall govern, *provided, however*, that the fact that a term or provision appears in this Amendment but not in the Agreement, or in the Agreement but not in this Amendment, shall not be interpreted as, or deemed grounds for finding, a conflict for purposes of this paragraph 3.
4. EXCEPT AS MODIFIED HEREIN, ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE UNDERLYING AGREEMENT SHALL REMAIN UNCHANGED AND IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.
5. In entering into this Amendment, neither Party waives, and each Party expressly reserves, any rights, remedies or arguments it may have at law or under the intervening law or regulatory change provisions in the underlying Agreement (including intervening law rights asserted by either Party via written notice predating this Amendment) with respect to any orders, decisions, legislation or proceedings and any remands thereof, which the Parties have not yet fully incorporated into this Agreement or which may be the subject of further review.
6. For purposes of this Agreement, the AT&T Notice information as set forth in the General Terms and Conditions has been changed to the following:

7. This Amendment shall not modify or extend the Effective Date or Term of the underlying Agreement, but rather, shall be coterminous with such Agreement.
8. Pursuant to Wisconsin Statute § 196.40, this Amendment shall become effective ten (10) calendar days after the mailing date of the final order approving this Amendment ("Effective Date").
