## Seventh Amendment to Wireless Traffic Exchange Agreement

The Wireless Interconnection Agreement, effective the 15th day of April 2004, between the TDS Telecommunications Corporation affiliates or subsidiaries identified on Appendix A of the named Agreement ("TDS TELECOM"), and United States Cellular Corporation, a Delaware corporation ("USCC"), approved by the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin in 05-TI-1125 on November 22, 2004 is hereby amended as follows:

To Appendix A – Reciprocal Compensation Rates and Billing Procedures, the following Companies and \$/MOU to be added under Type 2B Direct Interconnection:

To Appendix B – Direct Interconnection Points, the following meet point shall be added under Type 2B Interconnection Service:

12. The meet point for traffic to and/or from the Elkhorn exchange of TDS TELECOM shall be at the Elkhorn central office (ELKHWIXBDS1).

The remaining terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in effect. This Amendment shall be effective as of November 30, 2009 and supersedes the Interconnection Agreement for a Wireless System effective May 1, 2000 between State Long Distance Company and United States Cellular Corporation.
