**AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN  
BULLSEYE TELECOM, INC.  
AND

AT&T MICHIGAN, THE OHIO BELL TELEPHONE COMPANY D/B/A AT&T OHIO AND WISCONSIN  
BELL, INC. D/B/A AT&T WISCONSIN**

This Amendment (the "Amendment") amends the Interconnection Agreement under Sections 251 and 252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 by and between Illinois Bell Telephone Company d/b/a **AT&T ILLINOIS**, Indiana Bell Telephone Company Incorporated d/b/a **AT&T INDIANA**, Michigan Bell Telephone Company d/b/a **AT&T MICHIGAN**, The Ohio Bell Telephone Company d/b/a **AT&T OHIO** and Wisconsin Bell, Inc. d/b/a **AT&T WISCONSIN** ("**AT&T**") and BullsEye Telecom, Inc. ("**CLEC**"). **AT&T** and **CLEC** are hereinafter referred to collectively as the "**Parties**" and individually as a "**Party**".

**WHEREAS**, **AT&T** and **CLEC** are parties to an Interconnection Agreement under Sections 251 and 252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1934, as amended (the "**Act**"), as executed by the last Party on December 19, 2001 and as subsequently amended (the "**Agreement**"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties desire to modify certain rates and terms related to Emergency Number Service Access; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the promises and mutual agreements set forth herein, the Parties agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. The rates for Emergency Number Service Access in Exhibit A attached supersede the corresponding recurring and nonrecurring rates for ANI/ALI/SR and Database Management.
2. **AT&T** shall no longer provide ANI/ALI/SR and Database Management Access Routing Files, also known as the Master Street Address Guide (MSAG), via CD-ROM, and the CD-ROM rate in the Appendix Pricing is deleted.
3. Conflict between this Amendment and the Agreement. This Amendment shall be deemed to revise the terms and provisions of the Agreement only to the extent necessary to give effect to the terms and provisions of this Amendment. In the event of a conflict between the terms and provisions of this Amendment and the terms and provisions of the Agreement this Amendment shall govern, *provided, however*, that the fact that a term or provision appears in this Amendment but not in the Agreement, or in the Agreement but not in this Amendment, shall not be interpreted as, or deemed grounds for finding, a conflict for purposes of this paragraph 3.
4. EXCEPT AS MODIFIED HEREIN, ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE UNDERLYING AGREEMENT SHALL REMAIN UNCHANGED AND IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.
5. In entering into this Amendment, neither Party waives, and each Party expressly reserves, any rights, remedies or arguments it may have at law or under the intervening law or regulatory change provisions in the underlying Agreement (including intervening law rights asserted by either Party via written notice predating this Amendment) with respect to any orders, decisions, legislation or proceedings and any remands thereof, which the Parties have not yet fully incorporated into this Agreement or which may be the subject of further review.
6. This Amendment shall not modify or extend the Effective Date or Term of the underlying Agreement, but rather, shall be coterminous with such Agreement.
7. For all States except Ohio, and Wisconsin: This Amendment shall be filed with and is subject to approval by the applicable state Commission and shall become effective ten (10) days following approval by such Commission. For Ohio: Based on the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio Rules, the Amendment is effective upon filing and is deemed approved by operation of law on the 91<sup>st</sup> day after filing. For Wisconsin: Pursuant to Wisconsin Statute § 196.40, this Amendment shall become effective ten (10) calendar days after the mailing date of the final order approving this Amendment ("**Effective Date**").
