RE: Request to Approve Fifth Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement between TDS Telecommunications Corporation and Charter Fiberlink CCO, LLC, Pursuant to 47 U.S.C. Section 252(e)

TDS TELECOM hereby requests approval of the Fifth Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement between TDS Telecommunications Corporation (TDS Telecom) and Charter Fiberlink CCO, LLC (Charter) pursuant to 47 U.S.C. s. 252(e). The Amendment adds Mid-Plains to Schedule I and allows the companies to terminate each other's local traffic on a bill and keep basis. The original Interconnection Agreement between TDS Telecom and Charter was approved by the Commission in Docket 5-TI-1523 on March 28, 2006.

The amendment was effective June 1, 2013. It supersedes and terminates the Interconnection Agreement between Charter Fiberlink CCO, LLC (successor-in-interest to Charter Fiberlink, LLC) and Mid-Plains Telephone, LLC d/b/a TDS Telecom dated November 22, 2004 and approved by the Commission on January 31, 2005 in Docket 5-TI-1153.
