Public Hearing Scheduled for WPS Final Rate Increase

MADISON – The Public Service Commission (PSC) will hold a public hearing on the final fuel rate increase filed by Wisconsin Public Service (WPS) on Thursday, July 22 at 9:00 a.m. at the Public Service Commission, 610 North Whitney Way, Madison.

The PSC held a public hearing to determine the interim rate increase in March and granted WPS \$8 million to cover higher fuel costs. The interim rate increase is subject to a customer refund at 12% interest if the Commission later determines that the interim increase was not reasonable when it makes the final determination.

Citizens are invited to attend the public hearing in order to provide testimony that will be included in the record that the Commission will review as it prepares to make the final decision. The PSC will also accept any additional written comments at the public hearing. The hearing is set to begin:
