PSC to Hold Additional Public Hearing on Proposed Waunakee Line

*Those not able to testify at previous hearings provided
additional hearing to voice their opinions*

MADISON – Due to the recent extreme weather, the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSC) will hold an additional public hearing in Waunakee on February 15 regarding American Transmission Company's (ATC) application to construct a new transmission line in the Waunakee area. Public hearings for this case were held on February 3 and 5 in Madison and Waunakee respectively. However, the extremely cold temperatures may have prevented some from attending.

Those unable to attend the previous hearings are invited to provide testimony on ATC's request to build approximately 8 miles of new 138 kilovolt transmission line from the North Madison substation in the town of Vienna to the Huiskamp substation in the town of Westport. Only persons who have not already testified may testify at this additional hearing session. The hearing is scheduled for:
