## **PSC to Hold a Public Hearing on City of Waukesha Water Utility's Rate Proposal** *Public Encouraged to Provide Comments*

MADISON – The Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSC) will hold a public hearing on May 10<sup>th</sup> in Madison and Waukesha regarding the City of Waukesha Water Utility's request to change its water rates.

The City of Waukesha Water Utility is proposing to change rates for its customers effective this summer. The utility is also proposing a new rate structure for residential customers that would encourage water conservation. The proposed structure would charge higher rates for residential customers using more than 30,000 gallons per billing period.

Public comments on the City of Waukesha Water Utility's application will be included in the record the Commission will review in making a decision. The Commission has the authority to approve, deny or modify the application. Citizens are encouraged to attend either location of the hearing, which is scheduled for:
