PSC to Hold Public Hearings on Proposed Sale of Point Beach Nuclear Power Plant *Public Encouraged to Provide Comments*

MADISON – The Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSC) will hold public hearings in Manitowoc on June 14th regarding an application from We Energies to sell the Point Beach Nuclear Power Plant to FPL Energy Point Beach, LLC.

The two utilities must have the approval of the Commission, in addition to the approval of other governmental entities, to sell the nuclear power plant. If approved as submitted, FPL Energy will gain all ownership and operational control of the plant while allowing We Energies to purchase energy produced at the plant. The Commission will look at the economic and ownership impacts of the sale on Wisconsin's ratepayers and utilities to determine if the sale is in the best interest of the public.

Public comments on the application will be included in the record the Commission will review to make a decision on the proposed sale. The Commission has the authority to approve, deny or modify the application. Citizens are encouraged to attend one of the hearings and provide comments, which are scheduled for:
