## PSC Holds Public Hearings on Sale of Kewaunee Plant

MADISON - The Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSC) will hold a public hearing in Manitowoc, Wis. on Thursday, June 24 as it considers the application by Wisconsin Public Service Corporation and Wisconsin Power and Light Company to sell their jointly-owned Kewaunee nuclear power plant to Richmond, Virginia based Dominion Resources.

The two utilities must have the approval of the Commission, in addition to the approval of other governmental entities, to sell the nuclear power plant. The Commission will look at the economic impacts of the sale on the Wisconsin utilities and on the ratepayers and determine if the sale is in the best interest of Wisconsin citizens.

The approximate 575-megawatt Kewaunee plant achieved commercial operation in June of 1974 and is licensed by the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission to operate through December 21, 2013.

Citizens are invited to attend the public hearing in order to provide testimony that will be included in the record that the Commission will review as it prepares to make their decision. The PSC will also accept any additional written comments at the public hearing. The hearing is set to begin:
