PSC to Hold Public Hearings for Transmission Line in Central Wisconsin

*Public encouraged to provide comments on proposed
Gardner Park–Central Wisconsin, Morgan –Werner West project*

MADISON – The Public Service Commission (PSC) will hold public hearings in Weston, Clintonville and Shawano on April 18, 19 and 20th regarding American Transmission Company's (ATC) application to construct a transmission line in Marathon, Shawano, Oconto, Waupaca and Outagamie counties.

Citizens are invited to provide testimony on ATC's request to construct two 345-kilovolt power lines and one 138-kilovolt line in central and northeastern Wisconsin and a switching station in Shawano County. The total estimated cost of the project is approximately \$257 million.

Public comments on ATC's application will be included in the record the Commission will review to make a decision. The Commission has the authority to approve, modify or deny the application. Citizens are encouraged to attend the hearings, which are scheduled for:
