PSC to Hold Public Hearings on Proposed Transmission Facilities in Dodge County

Public encouraged to provide comments

MADISON – The Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSC) will hold public hearings in Hustisford on Tuesday, September 12 regarding American Transmission Company's (ATC) application to construct a transmission line and substation in Dodge County.

Citizens are invited to provide testimony on ATC's request to construct approximately 15 miles of a 138-kilovolt power line from the existing Rubicon Substation, just south of the village of Neosho, to a proposed new substation, to be named the Hubbard Substation, near the city of Horicon. If approved, ATC indicates that the transmission facilities would help improve electric reliability in the Dodge County area. The estimated cost of the proposed project is between \$17 and \$20 million.

Public comments on ATC's application will be included in the record that the Commission will review to make a decision. The Commission has the authority to approve, modify or deny the application. Citizens are encouraged to attend the hearings, which are scheduled for:
