## **PSC Approves Second Refund for WPSC Customers**

MADISON – Today the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSC) approved a \$15.6 million refund for electric customers of Wisconsin Public Service Corporation (WPSC). This is the second refund this year for WPSC customers, totaling almost \$30 million.

“The Commission has worked very hard this year to make sure ratepayers immediately see refunds due to the decrease in the natural gas market,” said Chairperson Dan Ebert. “This refund for WPSC customers, coupled with refunds that the Commission has granted for the other major utilities this year, means Wisconsin ratepayers have seen a total of \$115 million back in their pockets.”

The PSC performs monthly fuel costs audits and monitors how much the utility is collecting from customers. Earlier this year, the PSC determined that because of lower fuel costs, WPSC customers were due a \$14 million refund. As part of this regular monitoring, the PSC has identified that WPSC customers are entitled to another refund. The average residential customer can expect to see a refund of approximately \$5.40 on each of their November and December electric bills.

“This refund will provide some relief to WPSC customers,” said Commissioner Mark Meyer. “The PSC will continue to work diligently to get the money back into ratepayers’ hands as quickly as possible.”
