PSC and OCR Closed November 27, 2009

MADISON – The Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSC) and the Office of the Commissioner of Railroads (OCR) will be closed on Friday, November 27, 2009 as employees take one of 16 furlough days required for all state workers in the next two years. The PSC and the OCR will resume regular business hours on Monday, November 30.

The PSC Consumer Affairs telephone line, 1-800-225-7729, which offers live assistance, will be available on November 30.

Employee furloughs for all state employees are part of the 2009 – 2011 state budget recently signed into law. The furlough program will temporarily reduce salary costs by assigning employees to various dates or periods of unpaid time during what would otherwise have been scheduled work time.
