### **Governor Walker Appoints Mike Huebsch as incoming PSC Commissioner**

[Madison, Wis.] – Today, Governor Scott Walker appointed former Department of Administration Secretary Mike Heubsch to become the next Commissioner for the Public Service Commission.

All Commissioners are appointed by the governor to staggered six-year terms. Mr. Huebsch will be replacing outgoing Commissioner Eric Callisto at the PSC.

Mr. Huebsch was a member of the La Crosse County Board before serving the people of the 94<sup>th</sup> Assembly District with distinction for sixteen years. He served the people of Wisconsin as the Secretary of the Department of Administration since his appointment in January of 2011.

Mr. Huebsch was born in Milwaukee and has been a resident of La Crosse County for the last 40 years. He graduated from Onalaska High School and attended Oral Roberts University in Tulsa, Oklahoma. He currently lives in West Salem with his wife, Valerie, and their two children, Ryan and Brett.
