MADISON—Public Service Commission (PSC) Commissioner Tyler Huebner released the following statement in response to today’s vote in the Wisconsin State Senate:

“It has been an honor and privilege to serve the people of Wisconsin as a Public Service Commissioner over the past four years. The work of the Commission ensuring safe, reliable, affordable, and environmentally responsible utility services and equitable access to broadband is integral to the success and well-being of the people, businesses, and institutions across Wisconsin.
