

# ARPA BROADBAND ACCESS GRANT ELIGIBILITY GUIDANCE, FY 2022

The Interim Rule from the Federal Department of the U.S. Treasury defines, "unserved and underserved households or businesses as one or more households or businesses that are not currently served by a wireline connection that reliably delivers at least 25 Mbps download speed and 3 Mbps of upload speed." Interim Rule, C.F.R. § 35.6(e)(2). 86 Fed. Reg. 26786, 26823.

Area unserved by wireline internet access with at least 25 Mbps download and at least 3 Mbps upload.



Area with reported wireline service from a provider offering at least 25/3 speeds.



Area with no housing units, including water.
