



Application Open for ARPA Broadband Grants

The Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSC) released application instructions for the first round of Federal American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Broadband Access Grants. The Commission will be awarding up to \$100 million for projects that will expand high-speed broadband internet to unserved and underserved locations in the state. Applications for the ARPA Broadband Access Grants are due on **July 27, 2021**. The PSC expects to make award decisions in early fall.

In accordance with the U.S. Treasury guidance for the ARPA funds (86 Fed. Reg. 26786), eligible broadband projects are expected to:

- Serve unserved or underserved households and businesses, as defined by the U.S. Treasury.
- Be designed to deliver upon project completion internet service that reliably meets or exceeds symmetrical (upload and download) speeds of 100 Mbps (or at least 100 Mbps download and at least 20 Mbps upload, if it is not practicable to deliver the higher upload speeds due to geography, topography, or excessive costs), and be scalable to 100 Mbps upload in the future.

Internet service providers, telecommunications utilities, co-operatives, local governments, for profit and non-profit organizations are eligible to apply for grants. Approved projects must be completed by December 31, 2024, and there is no minimum or maximum amount of funding an applicant may request. Funds will be disbursed through a reimbursement process similar to the current process for the state Broadband Expansion Grant Program. 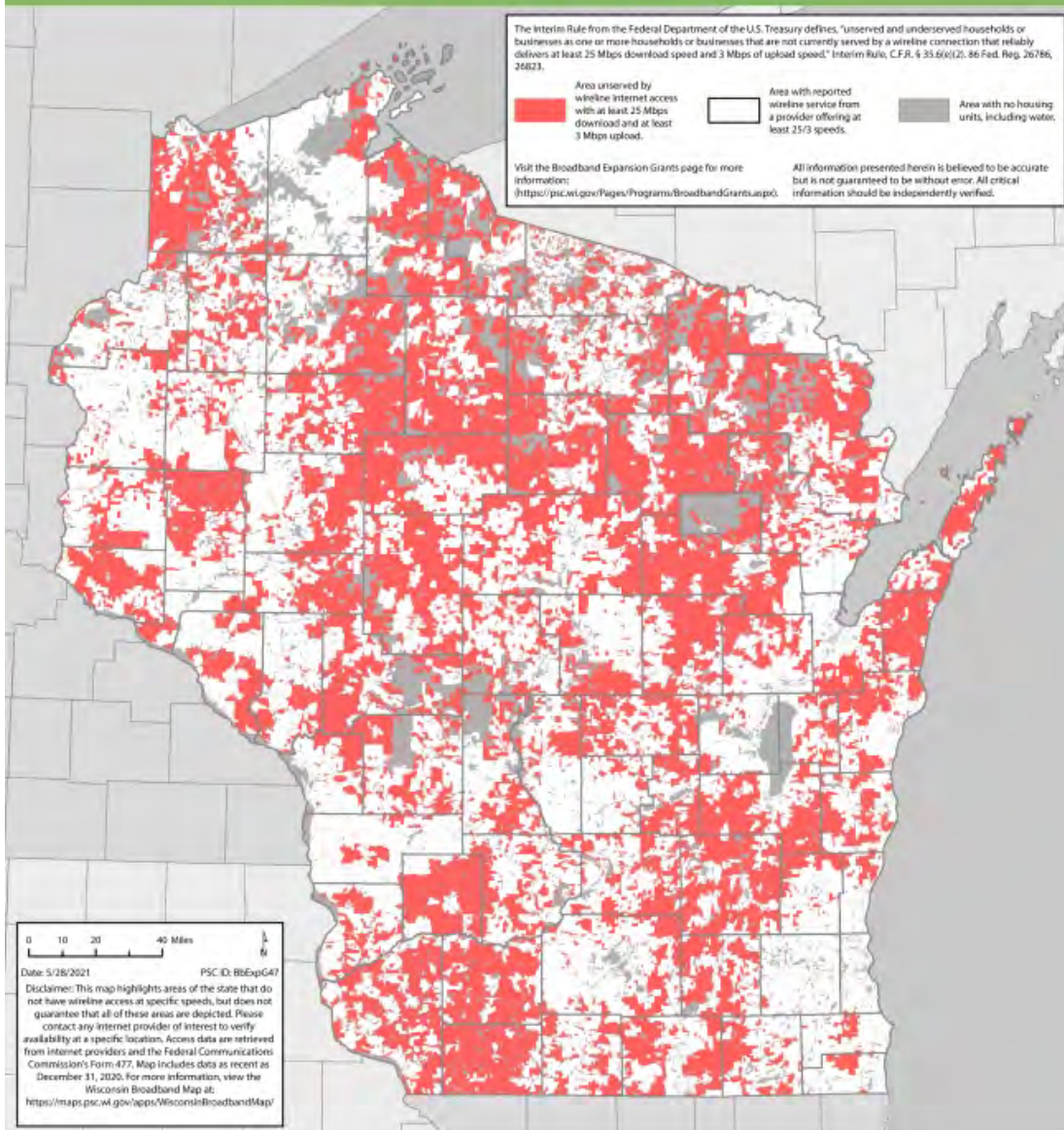

ARPA BROADBAND ACCESS GRANT ELIGIBILITY GUIDANCE, FY 2022

On Tuesday, June 1st the Broadband Office released a new map layer to provide guidance for the ARPA Broadband Access Grant Program. The updated map shows in red areas unserved by wireline internet access with at least 25 Mbps download and at least 3 Mbps upload. The areas in white show locations with reported wireline service from a provider offering at least 25/3 Mbps speeds.

The Wisconsin Broadband Office has made the ARPA Broadband Access Grant Eligibility Data available for download on the [data page](#) of the WBO, under the heading *ARPA Broadband Access Grant Eligibility Guide: Fiscal Year 2022*. The zip file includes the statewide census block files to identify un/underserved areas per the Interim Rule from the U.S. Treasury Department.
