WHEREAS; Wisconsin residents rely on safe drinking water from public water systems in their homes, schools, and workplaces;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Scott Walker, Governor of the State of Wisconsin,

SAFE DRINKING WATER WEEK


throughout the State of Wisconsin and I commend this observance to all of our citizens.
