PSC and OCR Closed Friday, May 28, 2010

MADISON – The Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSC) and the Office of the Commissioner of Railroads (OCR) will be closed on Friday, May 28, 2010 as employees take one of their 16 required furlough days. The PSC and the OCR will resume regular business hours on Tuesday, June 1, 2010 following Memorial Day.

The PSC Consumer Affairs telephone line, 1-800-225-7729, which offers live assistance, will be available on June 1.

Employee furloughs for all state employees are part of the 2009 – 2011 state budget. The furlough program will temporarily reduce salary costs by assigning employees to various dates or periods of unpaid time during what would otherwise have been scheduled work time.
