## **PSC and OCR Closed July 2, 2010**

MADISON – The Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSC) and the Office of the Commissioner of Railroads (OCR) will be closed on Friday, July 2, 2010 as employees take one of their 16 required furlough days. The PSC and the OCR will resume regular business hours on Tuesday, July 6 following the Fourth of July holiday.

The PSC Consumer Affairs telephone line, 1-800-225-7729, which offers live assistance, will be available on July 6.

Employee furloughs for all state employees are part of the 2009 – 2011 state budget. The furlough program temporarily reduces salary costs by assigning employees to various dates or periods of unpaid time during what would otherwise have been scheduled work time.
