PSC and OCR Closed February 21, 2011

MADISON – The Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSC) and the Office of the Commissioner of Railroads (OCR) will be closed on Monday, February 21, 2011 as employees take one of their 16 required furlough days. The PSC and the OCR will resume regular business hours on Tuesday, February 22, following the observance of Presidents Day.
