## The PSC has released a Draft Broadband Investment Plan for Region 6 *Now Accepting Public Comments*



MADISON - The Public Service Commission of Wisconsin appointed fifteen community leaders from the area to the Broadband Planning Team representing West Central Wisconsin. The Team represents Adams, Buffalo, Jackson, Juneau, La Crosse, Monroe, Trempealeau, and Vernon Counties. After considerable preliminary work, and numerous meetings, the Team has drafted a preliminary plan and seeks public comments.

The “Region 6 Broadband Planning Team” has been meeting regularly since last winter to create an action plan to address gaps in broadband availability and improve the adoption of available broadband services. The Region 6 Broadband Planning Team reflected a number of proposals and options. The draft plan is designed to enhance the regional economic development by implementing public outreach and promoting opportunities for greater collaboration among communities and broadband providers in the region.

The Team seeks public review and input on the current draft plan. The plan is available on-line at: [www.link.wisconsin.gov](http://www.link.wisconsin.gov). For those who may not presently have Internet access, the plan can be reviewed by accessing the Internet at local libraries and other public locations in the region.
