Environmental Impact Statement for CapX2020 Transmission Line Now Available

Public hearings have also been scheduled

Madison, WI - As a part of the evaluation for the proposed "CapX2020" transmission line in Western Wisconsin, the Public Service Commission (PSC) and the Department of Natural Resources have released a final version of the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) prepared for the project.

Copies of the EIS have been mailed to members of the public who previously requested them and to government agencies and municipalities within the project area. Digital documents associated with the EIS may be downloaded directly from the PSC's [website](#), listed under docket number 5-CE-136, or interested parties may request a digital copy on DVD. The PSC also has a limited number of hard copies available for those lacking access to a computer. After reviewing the EIS and other materials related to the project, the public is invited to comment via postal mail, online, or by attending upcoming public hearings.
