Chairperson announces State Representative Jeff Stone as incoming Division Administrator for the Division of Water, Compliance, and Consumer Affairs

[Madison, Wis.] – Today, Chairperson Phil Montgomery announced that Representative Jeff Stone has accepted the position of Division Administrator for the Division of Water, Compliance, and Consumer Affairs. This transition will take place once Representative Stone has vacated his position within the Assembly.

“Jeff will be a tremendous addition to the Public Service Commission, his service to the state as a legislator whom has served on a number of important committees will be a great asset to Wisconsin’s future” said Public Service Commission Chairperson Phil Montgomery. “Jeff is a solid voice of reason in the State Assembly and will bring that ‘Wisconsin First’ mentality to the Public Service Commission.”

Representative Stone was first elected to the Wisconsin State Assembly in a special election in 1998 and has represented the 82nd Assembly District ever since. His tenure as an elected official representing the needs of Wisconsinites will be greatly appreciated as the new Administrator for the Division of Water, Compliance, and Consumer Affairs.

The Public Service Commission of Wisconsin is the state regulatory agency that oversees the public utility industry and sets the rates that Wisconsin ratepayers pay for access to their public utilities.
