**Public Service Commission Now Accepting Applications for Medical Telecommunications  
Equipment Grants for Fiscal Year 2014**

[Madison, Wis.] - Today, the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin announced that they now accepting applications for Medical Telecommunications Equipment Grants for Fiscal Year 2014.

The Medical Telecommunications Equipment Grant Program was created to provide funding to nonprofit medical clinics, hospitals or public health agencies for the purchase of specialized telecommunications equipment designed to augment or enhance the delivery of medical services.

Generally, a grant from this program could be used to purchase video conferencing equipment that allows patients in rural locations to meet with medical specialists throughout the world without having to travel to a distant clinic. These grants can also be used to purchase home health monitoring devices which permit patients to record and report their health status from the convenience their home.

The Commission may award one or more grants that, in aggregate, do not exceed an annual total of \$500,000 during Fiscal Year 2014. Applications are due April 17, 2014.
