 - a. Alyssa Kenney to provide opportunity for future meetings
- 4. Rules 1-AC-251 Alyssa Kenney provided update: aligns Wisconsin Admin. Code ch. PSC 160 with FCC federal standards by incorporating Lifeline National Eligibility Verifier process to determine Lifeline eligibility and language revisions to include inclusive language. Rule recalled, Commission in the process of review.
- 5. Universal Service Fund fiscal audit and updates Jenna Schmidt provided update: Baker Tilly performed audit in place of the Legislative Audit Bureau, plan to transition to yearly audit. Financial statements are represented, no reportable findings identified/no deficiencies. Increased in assessments overall, decrease in amount of accessible revenue.
- 6. Telemedicine Grant Program update and budget plan Dennis Klaila provided update: Applications due February 10, 2022 for next round of grants that will be filled out and submitted online. Two budget years awarded at once for 2022/2023. 2023 Motion by David Mortimer to approve 2023 fiscal year budget round of \$500,000 for the upcoming budget and a second by Ted Hankins – motion approved
- 7. Universal Service Fund Commission updates Alyssa Kenney provided update: reorganization to a bureau to allow a federal grant team. Affordable Connectivity rolling out in 2022 and Non-Profit grant Program experienced an unusual number of extensions until February of 2022. New round of grants opening December 15, 2021 through the new EGrant System. Billy Mauldin provided TEPP update: 530 vouchers but decline overall, final version of new TEPP logo. Pete Jahn provided a Lifeline update: FCC phasing out support for voice services, but still providing some support State USF will reimburse providers. Tara Kiley provided an update on the EGrant

system: All applications managed in the system, required fields, controlled ending deadline, reporting and close out of grants
